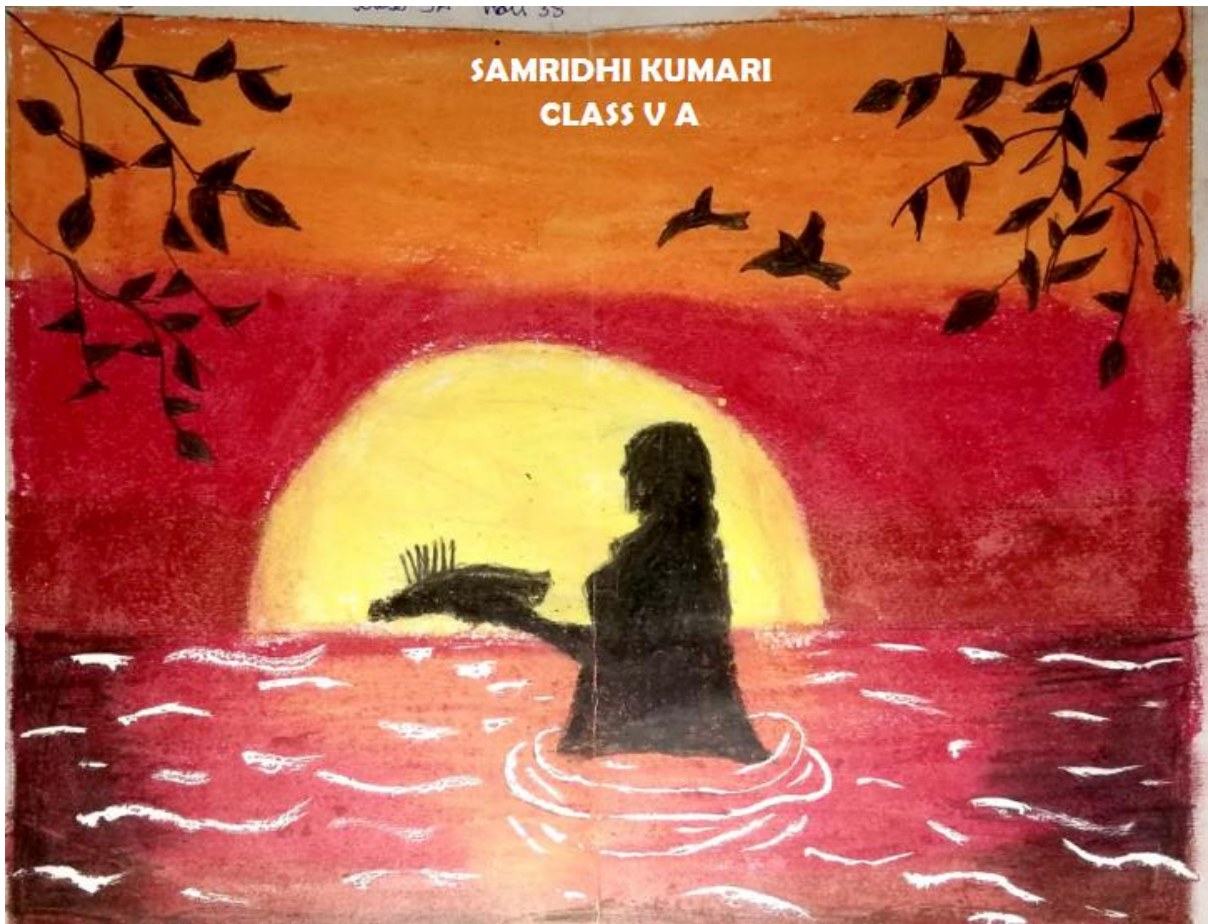

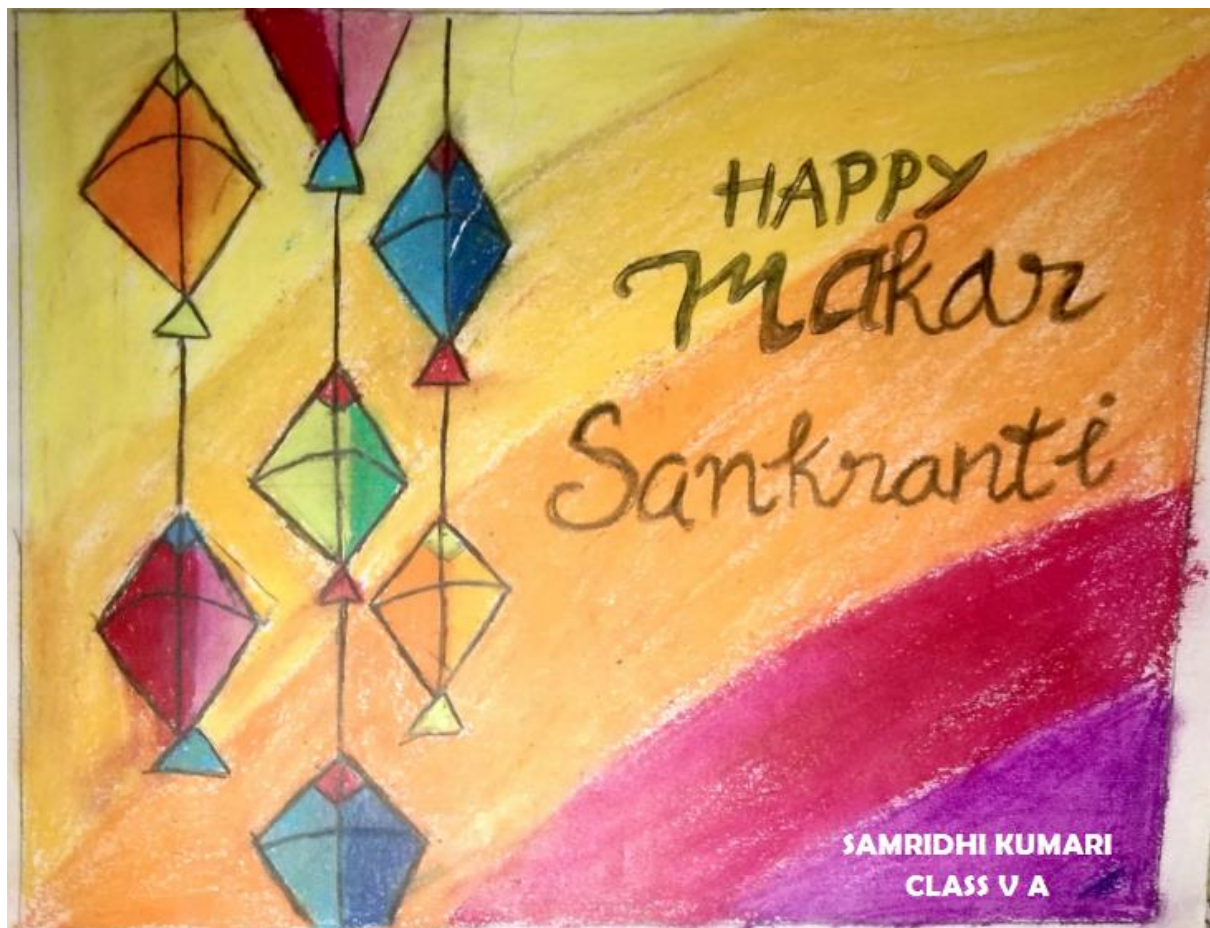

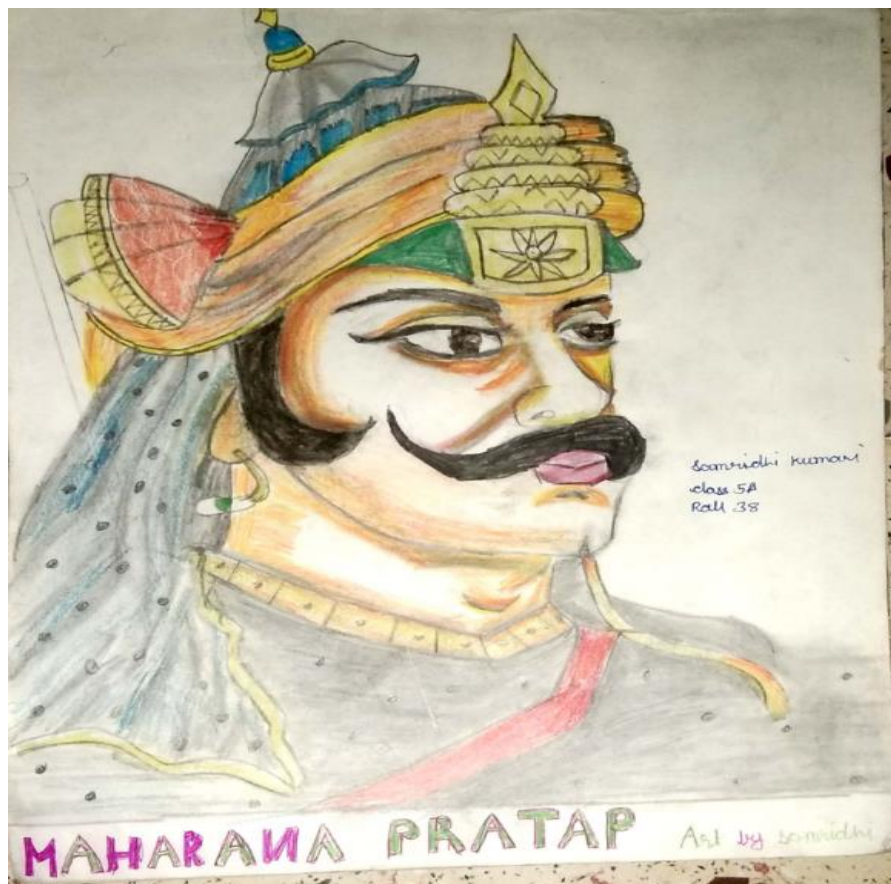

Article : Depth and Breadth of Manipur Conflict

I. Background:

We are witnessing one of the worst tribal conflict in Manipur state that started in May 2023 and growing like wildfire even now. The trigger for the conflict was the decision of the Government to accord “Scheduled Tribe (ST)” status to **Meitei** community opposing which Kuki tribals started violent protests in Churachandpur district. Subsequently the Meiteis organised counter-protests and blockades leading to clashes spreading across Manipur. Now let us dissect and understand the reasons for such a horrific incident which is growing and growing bringing international attention.

II. History and Geography:

Manipur is a state in north-east India with a population of 3.2 million. Manipur is metaphorically called “The land of Jewels”, “The Switzerland of the East”, “the land where The Gods took to Dancing”. Manipur is bounded by Nagaland, Mizoram, Assam states and also Mynamar on east. The state consists of mainly eastern wing of the Himalayas and a small tract of the plains. Himalaya hills constitute an important feature of the landscape of Manipur.

During the Second World War, Manipur was the battle field between Japanese and Allied forces. After war is over, Maharaja Bodhachandra signed a Treaty of Accession to merge the kingdom into India. It was made a union territory in 1956 and a state on 21st January 1972.

III. People:

Manipur is home to many tribes and tribal sects like Meitei, Naga, Kuki, Zomu, Thadou, Hmar, Zou, Vaiphei, Gangte, Simte, Tiddim, Paite, Sukte etc. But out of these two sects dominate the Region viz, Meteies with about 40% of the population and settled in plains with rich agriculture sources ; the other one is Kukis with about 50% of the population settled mainly in forest and hill lands.

In 1901, the Meiteis were recorded as the main ethnicity of Manipur. Nagas and Kuki/Zo are the major tribe conglomerates of tribes. The Kukis are divided into numerous tribes like Thadou people, Hmar people, Zou people, Vaiphei people, Gangte people, Simte people, Tiddim people, Paite people, Sukte people etc.

IV. The conflict

The ethnic conflict between majority Meitei community and the minority Kuki tribe started since May this year has a long history with multiple reasons. Majority Kukis are inhabitants of hills and forest is the base of their livelihood. Whereas the the minority Meiteis have settled in plains and have control over the Government. The government is accused discriminating Kukis and forced their eviction from the forests in the name of environment conservation. This is a threat to the security of their land and livelihood.

In May, the court upheld the decision of the Government to accord ST status to rich and affluent Meiteis. This has resulted in them to the same economic benefits and quotas in government jobs and education as the minority Kukis. In Manipur state, only STs can buy land in hilly areas. Classification of Meiteis as ST allowed them to buy land in the hills, where the Kukis predominately live. This has resulted in unrest in Kukis resulting in violent protests.

Manipur has border with Myanmar and Kuki and other smaller tribes inhabit hills in Manipur as well as bordering Myanmar. They have familial ties. To ease the movement of people, India and Mynmar have an agreement called Free Movement Regime (FMR). As per the Agreement, people from both sides can visit other side without visa upto 16 km. This has resulted in many illegal immigrants to India as there is a turmoil in Myanmar. Meiteis have concerns that the hills will be occupied completely by these illegal immigrants. Meitieis are ruling and police is accused not helping the Kuki community in the violence.

V. Conclusion:

Whosoever is right or wrong, only wish is peace should prevail. And any conflict can be sorted out through dialogues and mediation. The Government should take all steps to control the situation and protect life.
